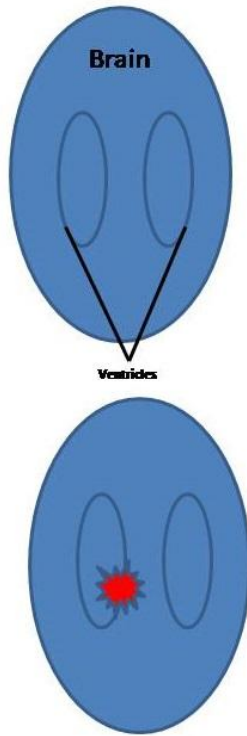


Intraventricular Hemorrhage (IVH)



Intraventricular Hemorrhage (IVH)

Premature brain vessels are very friable and can bleed spontaneously. The bleeding is graded (I, II, III and intraparenchymal) depending upon the extent.

Most IVHs are small and does not require any special treatment. However larger bleeds need close follow up and might need surgical intervention. Larger bleeds are associated with potential neurological complications.
